Description

Evergreen conifer with dense, thick needles on upright, bushy pine gives appearance of a penguin. Sun to part shade. 2" - 4" growth per year, 3' tall x 1.5' wide in 10 years.

Description

Highbush blueberry. Deciduous. 6'-7' tall by 3'-4' wide. Full sun. Medium to wet soil. Good fall color.

Description

Evergreen conifer. Light green spring growth matures to deep black-green in summer. Dense, irregular pyramid shape. Part to full sun. Water weekly. 6'-10' tall, 3'-4' wide.

Description

Moderate growing evergreen, 10' tall and wide. Filtered sun. Pink-edged white blooms with yellow stamens. Blooms fall through winter.

Hardy fuchsia, maroon sepals and dark purple-black petals, glossy green foliage. Upright form. Purple-black berries. Partial shade to full sun, keep soil moist but not soggy. 5' tall, 4' wide.

Description

Very dwarf, conical, very slow growing Hinoki cypress with layered branches and branchlets; and nice green foliage. After 10 years of growth, only 6 inches tall and 8 inches wide. Great for containers.

Description

Tall evergreen shrub, 14' high x 10'-12' wide. Well drained soil. Sun to mostly shade. Yellow flowers spring & winter. Smells like chocolate chip cookies when it blooms.
